
As a letterboxer



- I will respect the land.

- I will not disturb animals or their habitats.
- I will stay on trails unless clues lead me off the trail.
- I will leave the letterbox as I would hope to find it; returning all contents and carefully hiding it in the same place it was found.
- I will remove any trash I find.

Hike the trails. Record your letter stamp finds.

Letterboxes have been planted on the Nature Preserves and Sanctuaries that are part of Flanders Nature Center & Land Trust. One box on each hike has an extra stamp: a letter to put in your Flanders Passport. Record the letter stamp and the name of the hike where you found it. Add blank pages so you have room to record all your finds. When you have recorded 12 hikes and have 12 letters stamped in your passport you can receive a prize.

Additional letterboxing hikes are being developed and The Two Adventuring Ladies will eventually have more than 12 hikes for you to enjoy. All will have letter stamps. Hikes will be posted on the Flanders website.
