

Enhanced Health and Safety Precautions in light of Covid-19

Flanders Nature Center & Land Trust welcomes thousands each year to our many nature preserves and thousands more to our main campus on the Van Vleck Sanctuary. We are deeply committed to our guest's safety and routinely monitor our trails and outdoor teaching spaces, as well as routinely clean our indoor teaching and public use spaces. Masks must be worn at all times while inside buildings at Flanders. Masks must also be worn by adults outside if you are unable to social distance. Children are not required to wear masks outside when able to social distance while engaged in outdoor activities. Children must wear masks when inside buildings at Flanders.

We have taken additional steps in light of the coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic as it relates to activities here at Flanders. We have increased the frequency of professional cleaning in our indoor teaching spaces. All high-touch areas (desks, countertops, door handles, etc.) are cleaned with a disinfectant following a field trip or class use. We are asking our staff, volunteers and guests to follow public health recommended hand washing and additional sanitation efforts to prevent spreading the virus.

Especially since many activities at Flanders are held outdoors, we will continue to offer our schedule of programs, however we will monitor the situation on a daily basis for the safety and wellbeing of our guests.
