

Acquisition of Tomlinson Properties

One of our greatest responsibilities as an accredited Land Trust is the management of 2,300 acres of land which has been acquired through donation or purchase.

Flanders is proud to announce that this year, the Land Acquisition subcommittee, led by Vice President of the Board of Directors, Sharon Feeley acquired 38 acres of land in the Northeastern portion of Woodbury. This land, consisting of a 12.06-acre parcel and a 26-acre parcel was graciously donated by Timothy Tomlinson.

The committee and Flanders wish to thank Mr. Tomlinson, Attorney Paul Jessell of Savin, Staussacher & Scott and The Baldridge Family for their instrumental work in helping to preserve this piece of land.

This acquisition furthers Flanders mission of preserving and stewarding land and helps to increase the amount of open space in Woodbury, something that greatly benefits the entire community and the many species of plants and animals who call the land home.

Checking in with The Goats of Flanders

We're not kidding around, our goats are truly something special! We met up with Farm Manager and Educator Dianne Parmalee who filled us in on what makes our Dwarf Nigerian Milking Goats an important part of Flanders.

Dianne started with Flanders 19 years ago and after running many educational programs for children, realized that the center needed a small, friendly animal that could be used as a teaching tool. Dianne grew up with a goat as a pet and knew that they were great for our younger visitors.



Dwarf Nigerian Goats are smaller—and unlike some of their larger counterparts—are friendlier, more curious and sometimes even "cuddly." Dianne loves using our 20 goats to educate children during Farm School and Summer Camp. She specifically loves taking the younger learners out on hikes with the goats where they learn valuable lessons about invasive species and the important role goats can play in keeping them under control.

If you have yet to say hello to our furry friends, check out our upcoming Farm School programs and be on the lookout for Goat Yoga in the summer and fall months!
