Drive the same route as Francisco De Orellana walked when he discovered the Amazon River. We will climb up the Central Andes chain and cross Papallacta Pass. Birds, mountain vistas, photography: Visit Cayambe-Coca National Park and Cuyuja River. Stop in the Paramo for a regional 'trout' lunch – overlooking mountain vistas. Suggested photo gear to bring?

Small lightweight digital for all around photography is good.

For Birding it helps to have a longer telephoto lens --

In the range of 80 or 100mm – 400mm, 150 – 600mm, or a prime 500mm or 600mm lens. If you have a long lens a monopod might be more useful over a tripod on hikes. Cross shoulder sling straps are great if you carry a long and heavy lens vs. a neck strap.

For general landscape and scenes anything from a normal 50mm lens to a 24 – 70mm zoom, or longer is great.

A macro lens can be useful for close-ups of flowers, plants and insects, etc., but not necessary.
